- The Lisbon Agenda

- EU "the most competitive and dynamic knowledge-based economy in the world by 2010"
- In 2002, they set the objective of "making [European] education and training systems a world quality reference by 2010". COM(2007) 61
- §6 "The knowledge society is the key to the Lisbon Strategy"
  - Council of the EU Brussels 21 February 2005, Conclusions

- Broader than the autonomous Bologna Process



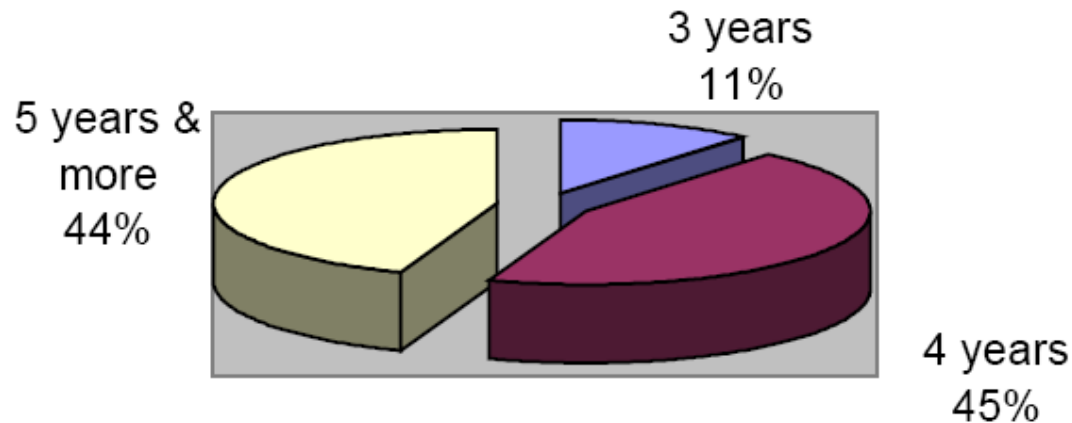


# Bologna Declaration

- o European Space for Higher Education by 2010
- o Restructuring
  - mainly organised in undergraduate / postgraduate phases / Bachelor - master - doctoral phases
- o Easily readable and comparable degrees
- o Credit accumulation and transfer systems
- o Quality assurance

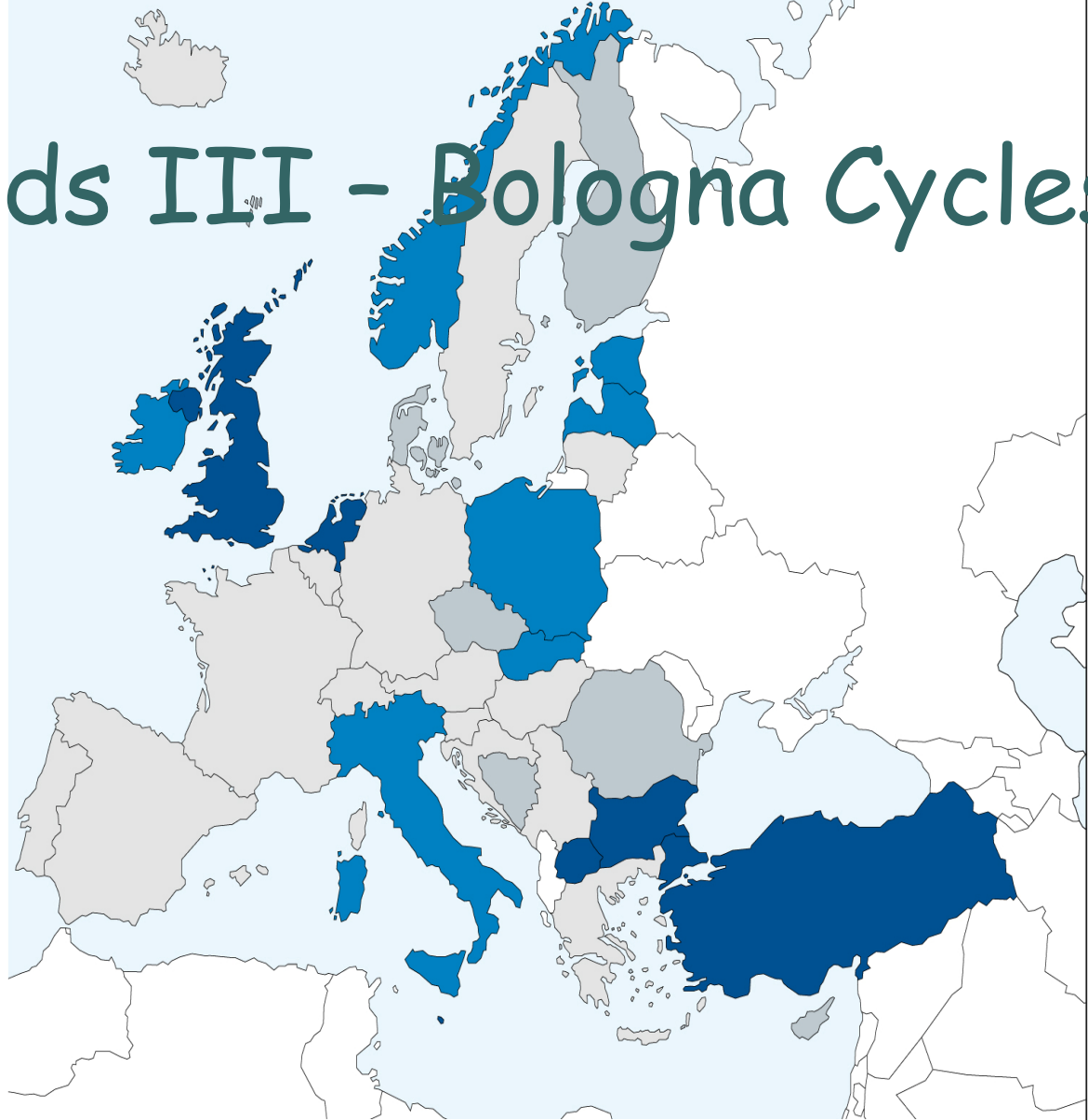

85-100 %	7

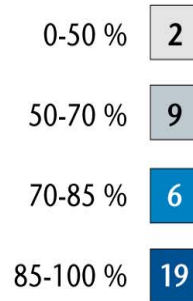

transparency for students and graduates

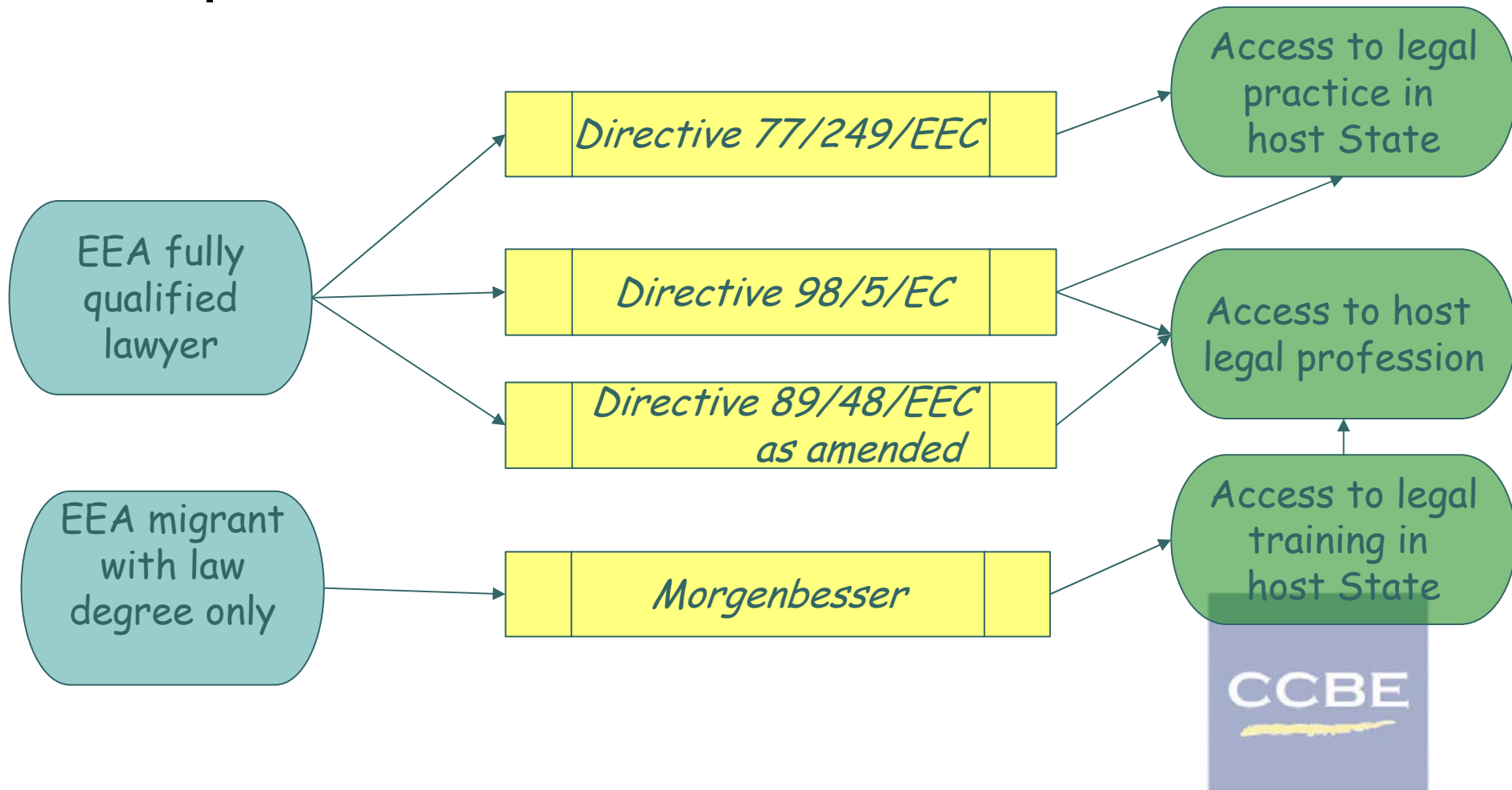
Assist European co-operation

Assist development of European labour market

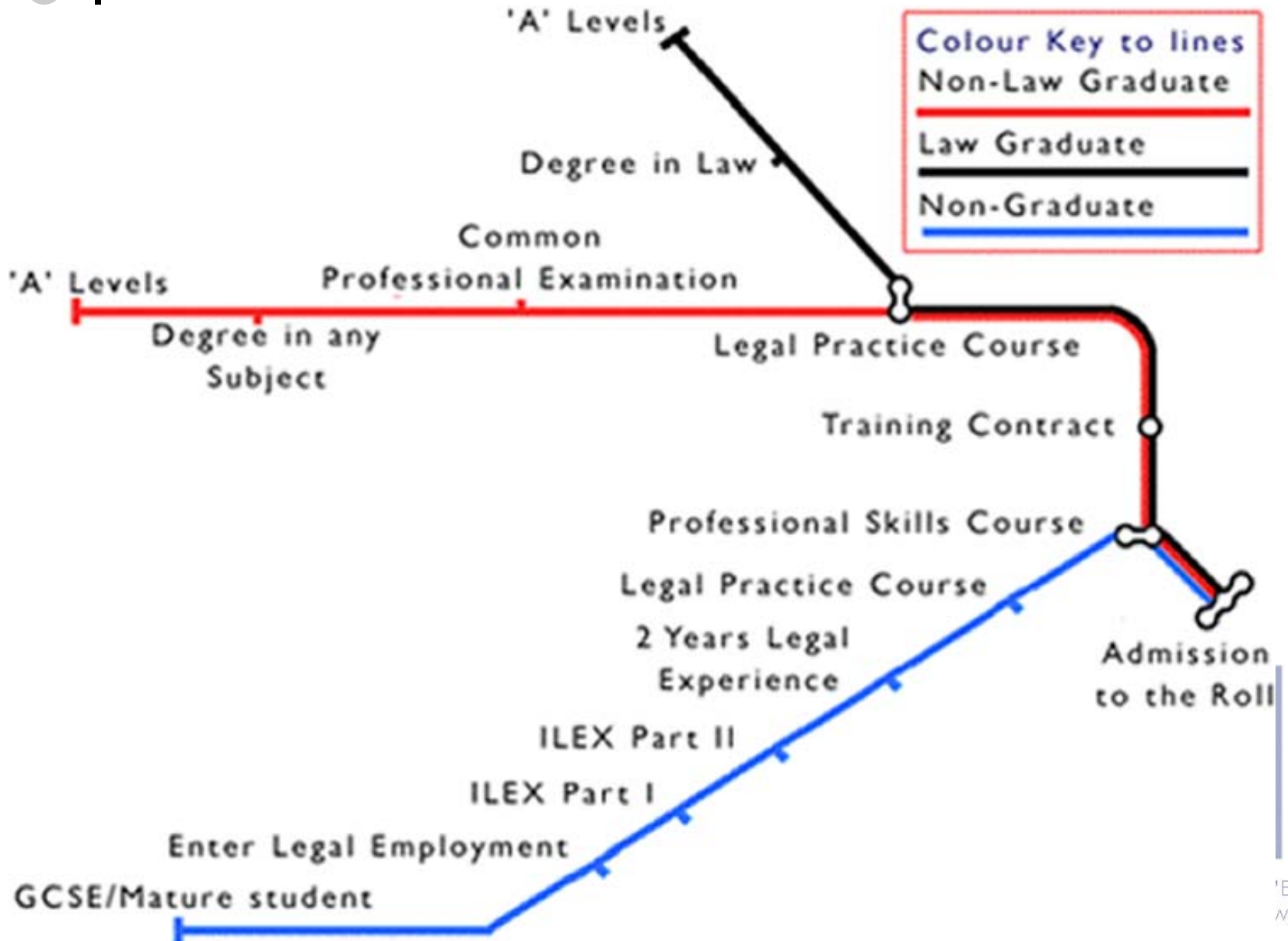




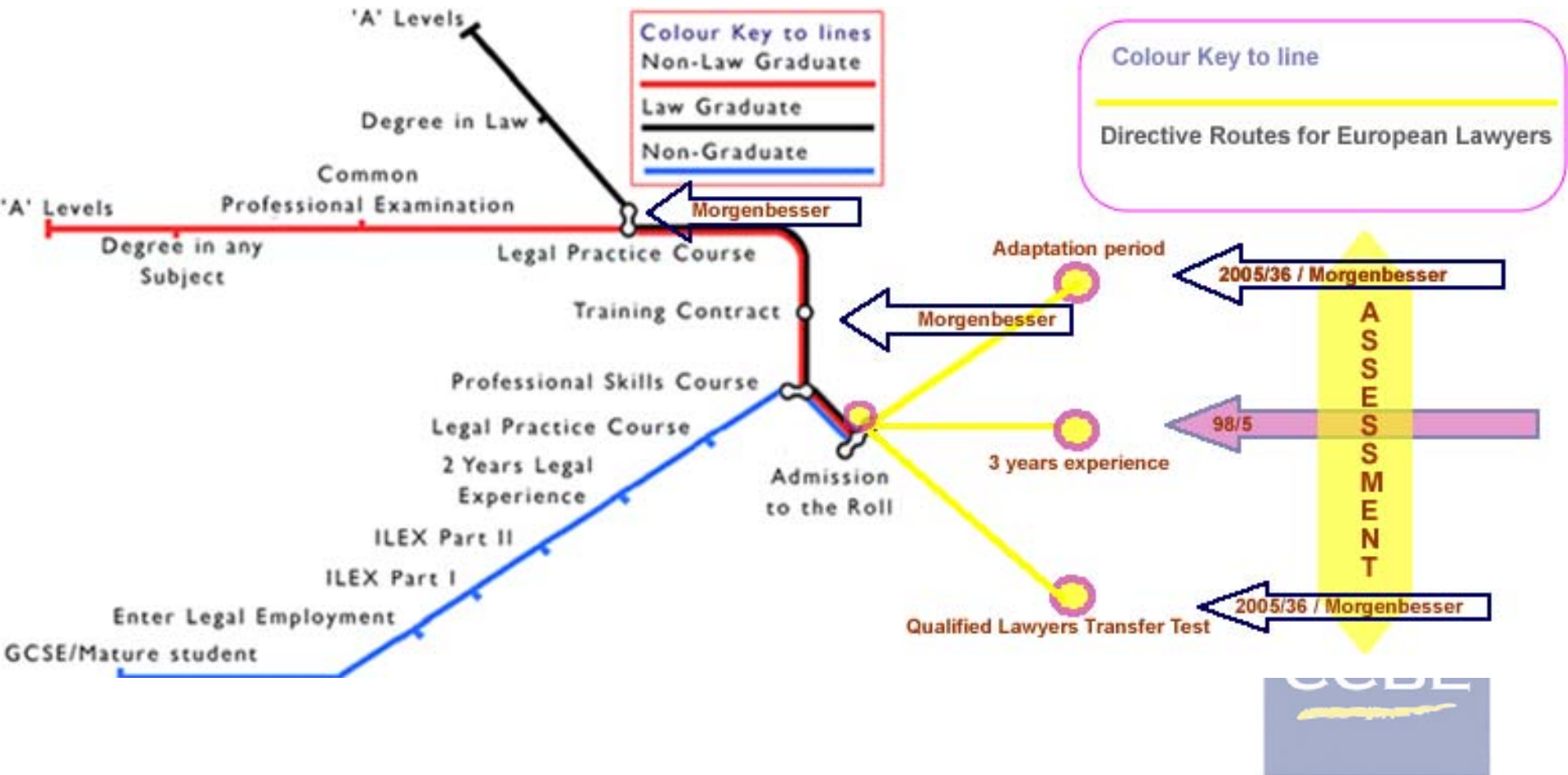
