Philippe Lortie, a Canadian citizen, holds a degree from the École des HEC (Montreal), a civil law degree, common law degree from the Ottawa University and a LLM in international law for which he received several prizes. He has been a member of the Quebec Bar since 1991.

He joined the Justice Ministry in 1991 where he mainly practices constitutional law and international law. He was the head of the Canadian delegation within UNIDROIT, UNCITRAL and The Hague Conference from 1997 to 2001. Furthermore, he taught law of international commercial transactions at the Ottawa University from 1998 to 2001. He was seconded national experts from a third country to the DG JHA during summer 2000.

Philippe Lortie has been First Secretary of The Hague Conference since 1st September 2001. He mainly works on international protection of children and information technologies.
