Since 2010, Simone Cuomo is a staff member of the Council of Bars and Law Societies of Europe (CCBE) where he currently holds the position of Acting Secretary-General. Besides policy advocacy and legal analysis, he has managed as Senior Legal Advisor a range of CCBE committees in areas of IT law as well as judicial cooperation in civil and criminal matters. He also manages the CCBE's activities with the European Commission for the Efficiency of Justice of the Council of Europe (CEPEJ) where he contributed to various guides and policy papers.
